

Artistic Director

Every ballet starts with a dream.

— A dream to dance with heart and soul, to tell a story, to enter a world of wonder and artistry.

OB18 will bring the dreams of many talented artists to life, with ballets that will energise and challenge our dancers as much as they will entertain and thrill our audiences.

What a pleasure it was to ask Greg Horsman to create a new production of *La Bayadère*. Greg has a proven skill for re-interpreting the classics with freshness while respecting tradition; his sumptuous ballet will open QB18 in March.

Next is a powerful double-bill of works from two of ballet's most remarkable creative artists. Carlos Acosta's *Carmen* is a passionate tour-de-force, and Liam Scarlett's *Firebird* is a celebrated interpretation of the iconic 20th century ballet.

Five years after first gracing our stage, Ben
Stevenson's *Cinderella* has lost none of her charm and
sparkle. In response to demand, I am so pleased to
remount this magical production in QPAC's Lyric Theatre.

Following the first, sold-out season in 2017, a bold new *Bespoke* comes to Brisbane Powerhouse in November. We will collaborate with Expressions Dance Company, staging new works by choreographers Gabrielle Nankivell, Jack Lister and another special guest to be announced. Dance will also be celebrated through a number of visual art installations during this collaborative, creative project.

Ben Stevenson's delightful production of *The Nutcracker* will usher in the end-of-year holiday season with a festive flourish. Now an annual tradition in Brisbane, in 2018, our magic Christmas tree will grow even bigger on the Lyric Theatre stage!

Audiences in regional Queensland will enjoy Ben
Stevenson's acclaimed production of Swan Lake, on tour in
June/July. Later in the year, we will head to Melbourne with
Liam Scarlett's whimsical ballet, A Midsummer Night's Dream.

From 2018, QB will begin an exciting program of refurbishments to our home at the Thomas Dixon Centre. With the support of the Queensland Government and a major grant from the lan Potter Foundation, we have begun work on this important legacy project to create a truly world-class facility for our dancers, art workers and community. In the short-term, this means that we don't have certainty around the availability of our performance studio for a *Dance Dialogues* season in 2018. However, I urge everyone who enjoys the close-up experience of a studio season to come to *Bespoke*, and watch out for several QB Academy events later in the year, which will showcase the gifted young dancers in our Jette Parker Young Artist and Pre-Professional Programs.

We are grateful to the supporters who help us to pursue our dreams; in particular, our funding partners, the Queensland and Australian Governments. After three years as Lead Partner, Suncorp will increase its generous support, becoming Queensland Ballet's Principal Partner. Major Partners BMW, JCDecaux, QGC and Virgin continue to make a real difference to our operations, and we are delighted to announce that Spicers Retreats will now join us in 2018 as a Major Partner. We are also thankful for the generous support from other corporate and cultural partners, trusts and foundations, and individuals. — Carlos Acosta, former Principal of The Royal Ballet and one of the most acclaimed dancers in the world, has distilled the famous operatic story, *Carmen*, into a powerful, theatrical ballet — a tourde-force of raw, honest characters and thrilling dance.

Bizet's electrifying music underscores a tale of passion and betrayal.

Don José is hopelessly smitten by the free-spirited and sensual Carmen, but when she discards him for a dashing matador, his ardour turns to jealous rage.
